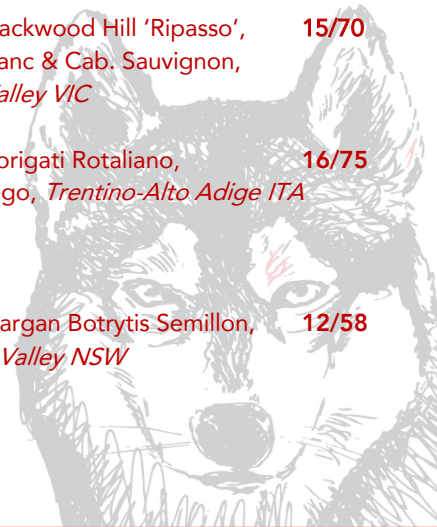

A fruit driven sparkling from Chardonnay & Pinot Noir varieties. Aromas of toasty brioche, delicate citrus, apples and full of crisp flavours!

2019 Adelina Wines, Riesling, Clare Valley SA \$60

Unique Riesling with white flower perfume, zesty cider apples with vanilla. Fine line of acidity with a zippy, sour-edged finish. Perfect for lighter and spicier dishes on the menu.

2019 Snake & Herring 'Tough Love', Chardonnay,

Margaret River WA \$70

Full flavour as we expect from our Margaret River Chardonnay. Ripe orchard fruits, nery wave of acidity and fine pithy phenolics. Refreshing medium body wine, with a sincere touch of oak flavours for complexity.

2017 Wild Duck 'White Duck', Roussanne & Viognier,

Heathcote VIC \$70

The White Duck represents both grape varieties in great fashion. Medium body wine with Roussanne's savoury notes, plumped with Viognier's stone fruit and plenty of texture to boot.

2019 Domaine Schlumberger, Gewurztraminer, Alsace FRA \$130

Our favourite match for all things spicy! Intense aromas of passionfruit's, mango, papaya, lychee and not forgetting the floral rose scents. White pear, vanilla, and candied ginger on the palate. Rich and smooth white wine.

Rosé

2019 Bush Track Rosé, Shiraz & Tinta Cao, Alpine Valleys VIC \$55

Attractive & vibrant Rosé, with orange blossoms and fresh raspberry notes. Crunchy red berries, soft creamy texture and a gentle dry finish. Everyday is a Rosé kinda day!

Red

2017 Bush Track, Cabernet Sauvignon, Alpine Valleys VIC \$65

A local producer for those heavy red wine lovers! Vibrant red currents, choc-mint, fresh bay leaf. Bright acidity, fine tannins, and a well-balanced satisfying wine. A touch of oak showing vanilla notes on the palate – smooth.

2021 Giant Steps 'Yarra Valley', Pinot Noir, Yarra Valley VIC \$70

A fantastic example of how great Pinot Noir is from the Yarra Valley! A blend of six vineyards in what was an excellent year in quality fruit. Perfumed red fruits, sweet spiced strawberry, red cherry with some savoury autumnal character. Light tannin, great energy for everyday drinking.

2021 Mac Forbes 'EB75 Candy', Pinot Meunier, Yarra Valley VIC \$70

The lightest red in the building, originally from Champagne - a moreish red, hard to put down like Candy! Subtle red fruits, earth and herbaceous. One for the Pinot Noir lovers who wish to try something different.

2016 Clay Pot Wines 'Pyrrha', Mataro, McLaren Vale SA \$130

Mataro is also known as Mourvèdre, a medium bodied grape, shown here in a savoury complex form with fine tannins. Super interesting wine, using ancient techniques, soaking in all it's glory in a single terracotta 'amphora' for 200 days before being basket pressed. Complex, and great fun for wine lovers!
